

## **NEOKLA REGION SCCA MINUTES MARCH 13, 2018**

**Autocross Report – Jeff Maize:** The first event is next Sunday at the Fairgrounds. The dates are set for the year. Check the website.

**National Convention Report – Jeff and Amanda Maize:** SCCA will donate \$500 for a Street Survival School. Tire Rack will donate \$750. We need to find a suitable, available site. There are changes to the junior driving program. Solo Safety Stewards will cover training. This year we would like to focus on novices and new members. Suggestions were made for identifying those willing to help newcomers. There will be spot checks conducted this year by the insurance department to assess handling of waivers. Anybody witnessing a waiver must be 18 or older.

**Road Racing – Betty Martin:** NEOKla has a Super Tour at Hallett on April 7-8. We need workers in all specialties.

**Road Rally – Garry Deaton:** There were 3 attendees at the rally school. The next event will be the Area 51 Rally on April 22, which will start at the Osage Casino in Skiatook and end at Woolaroc.
